- 1. Army Recruitment Rally will be held for eligible candidates of all districts of Nagaland from 03 Apr 2019 to 06 Apr 2019 at Bhagat Stadium, Rangapahar Military Station, Dimapur. Online registration is mandatory and will be open from 02 Feb 2019 to 18 Mar 2019. Admit Cards for the rally will be sent to registered e-mail from 19 Mar 2019 to 21 Mar 2019. Candidates must give their own email id in their own personal interest. Candidates should reach the venue on given date and time as mentioned in the Admit Card.
- 2. Candidates will be screened for following **Categories** and as per **Quantitative Requirements** mentioned below :-

Medical Test

- (a) As per laid down medical standards at the Rally Site.
- (b) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH/CH/BH for specialist review Candidates referred to specialist review should present themselves to the nominated MH/CH/BH within 14 days of the referral and report back to ARO for issue of Admit Card for Common Entrance Exam (CEE), in case declared FIT.

Written Test through Common Entrance Examination (CEE)

- (a) Will be conducted for medically FIT candidates at nominated venue, location, date and time of written test will be intimated at rally site and through Admit Cards.
- (b) Admit card for the CEE for the rally Fit candidates will be issued at Rally Site itself.
- (c) Admit card for the CEE for the Review Fit cases will be issued after being declared medically fit by concerned specialist / specialists at Military Hospital (MH)/ Command Hospital (CH) /Base Hospital (BH)

- 4. Candidates are required to bring following documents/certificates in original with two attested photocopies with them to the rally site :-
 - (a) Admit Card. Printed with Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
 - (b) **Photograph**. Twenty copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old. Computer printouts/photoshopped/morphed photographs will **NOT** be accepted.

(c) Education Certificates :-

- (i) Education Certificates with marks sheet in original of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/Intermediate/Graduation etc from recognised School/ College/Board/University.
- (ii) Provisional / online education certificate should be certified ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University.
- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by BEO/DEO.
- (d) <u>Domicile/Residence Certificate</u>. Domicile Certificate with photograph issued by DC/District Magistrate.
- (e) <u>Caste Certificate</u>. Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the DC/District Magistrate.
- (f) Religion Certificate. Religion Certificate issued by the DC/District Magistrate.
- (g) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Police Station within last six months.
- (h) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for candidates less than 21 years of age with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation within last six months.
- (j) <u>Relationship Certificate</u>. Son of Servicemen (SOS)/Son of Ex-servicemen (SOEX) / Son of Widow (SOW)/ Son of War Widow (SOWW) Candidates are required to produce the following documents;-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particulars of the Record Officer issued the Relationship Certificate with office seal /stamp is endorsed.
 - (ii) **A declaration** to the affect as mentioned in the Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp Paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/ Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. Format of affidavit attach as per **Appendix A**.
 - (iii) **Original Discharge Book of Ex-Serviceman** also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.
- (k) <u>NCC Certificate</u>. NCC A/B/C certificates and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. **Provisional NCC A/B/C pass certificates will only be accepted if authenticated by concerned NCC Group Commanders**.

(I) Sports Certificate.

- (i) Sportsmen who have represented **India** at **International level** and **State** at **National level** within the last two years.
- (ii) Sportsmen who have represented **District** at **State level** and University team or regional team at **District level with 1**st/**2**nd **position** within last two years.
- (m) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate.
- (n) <u>Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & AADHAR Card</u>. Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & Allowances and other social benefits scheme.
- 5. **Special Instructions**. Nil.

Important Instructions.

- 6. <u>Administration</u>. Candidates are advised to bring sufficient eatables and drinking water with them since recruitment is a time consuming process.
- 7. Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.
- 8. Recruitment into the army is a free service. Candidates are advised not to pay bribe to anyone for recruitment as it is based purely on merit. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is computerised and transparent. Therefore, candidates are advised to be beware of touts as they cannot help them at any stage.
- 9. Candidates are advised to check their age & education criteria before participating in the rally. Candidates found under age/overage and not meeting education criteria will be disqualified.
- 10. Giving/taking bribe, production of bogus/fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law.
- 11. Certificates with overwriting, tampering of seals or erasing/alteration of any type will not be accepted.
- 12. All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into Army. Strong legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents or giving wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite any number of years of service individual may have rendered.
- 13. No compensation for Death/injury/loss etc during the rally and no Travelling allowance/Dearness allowance for journey is admissible. Candidates will participate in the rally at their own risk and participation is totally and entirely voluntary.
- 14. <u>Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs</u>. Use of any king of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Candidates having been found to have used the same will be debarred from further screening.

15. <u>Tattoo</u>. Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e From inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

- 16. If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
- 17. Selection is provisional till Rahdari Certificate is issued and candidates are despatched for training.
- 18. Mobile phones are not permitted at the rally site and at the time of Run/PMT/PFT/Medical & Common Entrance Exam (CEE).
- 19. Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.
- 20. Candidates may have to present themselves at rally site for three to four days. Candidates should make arrangement for stay under their own arrangement.
- 21. Negative marking would be applicable in Common Entrance Exam (CEE).
- 22. Result of written examination will be declared on the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to ARO for documentation.
