1. Educational and other Qualifications for Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) Post

Essential

- (i) Master's Degree from a recognised University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms) in the following subject.

OR

Two years Integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the following subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms).

OR

Post Graduate degree in the following subjects with atleast 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms) from a recognized university and B.A.Ed. / B.Sc.Ed. from a recognized institute.

MODE OF SELECTION

- i Written test - The screening shall be made through objective type of test (MCQs) for 50 marks in the respective subject/s for 1½ hour. Candidates scoring 50% or above and 45% or above (SC/ST/OBC/Divyang) will be considered for Skill test.
- ii Skill test – For the candidates short-listed on the basis of written test.
Selected candidates will be empanelled and will be operated as per the arising temporary vacancies in AEC Schools/Jr. Colleges at Mumbai.
